April 1, Monday – Depart USA

Board your transatlantic flight to Warsaw via Frankfurt. Meals are served on board.

April 2, Tuesday – Warsaw

LH 1348 – FRA-WAW – 12.20/ 13.55 – Arrive Warsaw

On arrival meet your guide. Transfer to the Wola District, Warsaw.

4.00 pm - Divine Mercy Chaplet and Mass at Zytnia St.

7.00 pm – Dinner and overnight at the Ibis Stare Miasto Warsaw.

April 3, Wednesday – Warsaw

6.30 am – 7.30 am – Breakfast/ Departure.

8.20 am – Visit to the Warsaw Rising Museum with a local guide.

Lunch break in the Old Town, Warsaw.

1.00 pm – Mass at St. John's Cathedral followed by a prayer by the tomb of Cardinal Stefan Wyszyński.

2.00 pm – Afternoon guided tour of Warsaw includes Żoliborz with the tomb of blessed Fr Popiełuszko.

7.00 pm – Dinner and overnight at the Ibis Stare Miasto Warsaw.

April 4, Thursday – Warsaw – Plock – Uniejów

6.30 am – 8.00 am – Breakfast/ Departure

Transfer to Niepokalanów/50 km/, town founded by St. Maksymilian Kolbe.

9.30 am – Mass at St. Maximilian Kolbe Chapel followed by a visit of the Convent Museum.

Travel to Plock/70 km/.

12.00 am – Visit the Congregation of Our Lady of Mercy, place of the first revelation of the Merciful Christ to St. Faustina. Lunch break in Plock. Travel to Uniejów/120 km/.

Dinner and overnight at the Browar Wiatr Hotel, Uniejów.

April 5, Friday – Świnice Warckie – Głogowiec – Częstochowa

8.00 am – 9.00 am – Breakfast and check-out.

10.00 am – Mass at the Shrine of the Birth and Baptism of St Faustina, Świnice Warckie.

Visit the Family House of St. Faustina, Głogowiec. Transfer to Czestochowa/200 km/. Lunch en route.

7.30 pm – Dinner at the Hotel Mercure Centrum, Czestochowa.

9.00 pm – Appeal prayer at the Black Madonna Chapel/ optional/.

April 6, Saturday – Czestochowa – Auschwitz – Krakow

7.00 – 8.00 am – Breakfast and check-out.

9.00 am – Mass at the Rosary Chapel.

10.00 am – Guided tour of Jasna Góra Monastery with a local guide. Lunch in Jasna Góra.

12.30 pm – Transfer to Oswiecim. /100 km/

2.30 pm – Guided tour of Auschwitz Concentration Camp with a local guide.

Prayer at the St. Maksymilian Kolbe cell. Transfer to Wadowice /30 km/.

Dinner and overnight at the Młyn Jacka Hotel, Wadowice.

April 7, Sunday – Wadowice – Kalwaria – Ludzimirz – Zakopane

6.30 – 7.30 am – Breakfast and check-out. Transfer to Kalwaria Zebrzydowska /15 km/.

8.15 am – Mass at the Passion Chapel, Kalwaria Zebrzydowska.

9.00 am – Visit of Kalwaria with a local guide.

10.00 am – Transfer to Wadowice/15 km/.

11.00 am – Visit of the family house of John Paul II with a local guide.

Individual visit of the Basilica of Presentation of Our Lady, the baptismal church of John Paul II.

Lunch break in Wadowice. 2.30 pm – Transfer to Ludzimirz /75 km/.

Visit of the Shrine of "Our Lady" Gazdzina Podhala". Transfer to Zakopane /30 km/.
Dinner and overnight at the Sabała Hotel, Zakopane.

April 8, Monday – Zakopane –Krakow

7.00 – 11.00 am – Breakfast and late check-out. Free morning to enjoy the Krupówki St.

12.00 am – Mass at Our Lady of Fatima Basilica, Krzeptowki.

Lunch break in Zakopane. Afternoon transfer to Krakow/ 120 km/.

Dinner and overnight at the Pilgrims House, Lagiewniki, Krakow.

April 9, Tuesday – Krakow

7.30 am – Breakfast.

9.00 am – Mass at the Convent Chapel by the tomb of St Sister Faustina.

10.00 am – Guided tour of the Divine Mercy Shrine with a local nun.

11.45 am – Transfer to the Wawel Hill.

12.15 am – Guided tour of the Cathedral, the Royal Tombs and Treasury followed by a guided tour of the Old Town "In the footsteps of John Paul II" with a local guide.

Lunch break. Afternoon at leisure at the Old Town.

Dinner and overnight at the Pilgrims House.

April 10, Wednesday – Krakow – Wieliczka

7.00 – 8.00 am – Breakfast. Transfer to the Wieliczka Salt Mines /10 km/.

8.45 am – Guided tour with a local guide.

10.30 am – Mass at the underground chapel of John Paul II.

Transfer to Kraków for lunch break and free afternoon. Shopping opportunities.
